The event officially marked the start of a two-year international collaboration between partners from Romania 🇷🇴, Turkey 🇹🇷, and Bulgaria 🇧🇬, aiming to enhance inclusive education practices for students with Specific Learning Difficulties (SpLD), Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD), and AD/HD.

✓ The discussions focused on the SENvoice Methodology – a structured framework for accessible and engaging Science and Environmental Studies lessons designed for all learners.

Key objectives:

- Support teachers in adapting lessons for SEN students
- Develop two inclusive toolkits: Science for All (S4ALL) and Environment Studies for All (ES4ALL)
- Strengthen cooperation between schools and specialists
